 - O There was an acid spill in the exterior pool house on opening day. A pool repairman will be coming to correct the issue.
 - O At a cost of \$125 for the summer, MTCO will provide wifi for the pool. Spielman supported getting wifi at this rate.

 - a. Joan Garber gave Treasurer's report.
- 2. Director's Report
 - a. Deeb expressed a need for a time clock at the pool. The current system is inefficient.
 - b. Commerce cannot give governing bodies a debit card, but they will give a credit card.
 - c. Deeb and Joan are overworked handling employee paperwork. They need additional staff to complete registration and work the office.
 - d. Deeb will visit the library building to evaluate it as new office space.
 - e. All park employees will have a staff pass for the pool.
 - f. Pool employees are planning to use app Celly to send out notifications to patrons.
 - g. Alderson asked about the status of pool free days. Deeb discussed having a date at the end of the season as a 'thank you' to patrons and donors. Bring your dog to the pool day was also discussed.
