

MINUTES of a special public meeting of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Metamora Park District, Woodford County, Illinois, held in the Village Hall, 102 North Davenport, Metamora, Illinois, in said Park District at 6:50 o'clock P.M., on the 12th day of May, 2021.

The meeting was called to order by the President, and upon the roll being called, Matt Bidar, the President, and the following Park Commissioners were physically present at said location: Kerry Brock, Miranda Drostell.

The following Park Commissioners were allowed by a majority of the members of the Board of Park Commissioners in accordance with and to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the Board of Park Commissioners to attend the meeting by video or audio conference: n/a

No Park Commissioner was not permitted to attend the meeting by video or audio conference.

The following Park Commissioners were absent and did not participate in the meeting in any manner or to any extent whatsoever: Danion Baumann, Andrew Kamm

At 6:51 o'clock P.M., the President announced that the next agenda item for the Board of Park Commissioners was a public hearing (the "*Hearing*") to receive public comments on the proposal to sell bonds in the amount of \$300,000 for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto (the "*Park Bonds*") and explained that all persons desiring to be heard would have an opportunity to present written or oral testimony with respect thereto.

The President opened the discussion and explained that the reasons for the proposed issuance of the Park Bonds were as follows: for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto.

Whereupon the President asked for additional comments from the Park Commissioners. Additional comments were made by the following:


