

Metamora Pool Policy:

- The pool **will not open** if the temperature does not reach 70 degrees at the time of opening.
 - The pool **will not open** during inclement weather.
 - The pool **will close** due to electrical storms.
 - The pool **will close** due to low attendance.
- Any child in diapers is required to wear a **swim diaper** in the pool.
- Children 10 and under must be accompanied by a person 16 years or older.
- Only **Coast Guard-approved** life jackets are allowed in the pool.

***No coolers or outside food may be brought in during public swim hours**

THE POOL WILL ONLY ACCEPT CASH AND/OR CHECK

Daily admission rate: \$5.00

Age 2 and under: Free

Lap Swim: \$3:00

Twilight (after 5pm): \$3.00

Please note: Everyone entering the pool must either pay the daily rate or have a pass

Entrance to the pool is on a first come first serve basis. The pool will enforce maximum capacity guidelines.

COVID Protocols:

- Chairs will be spread apart and socially distanced
- As long as social distance can be maintained, masks will not be required for pool patrons.
- Limits to the number of people allowed in the facility will be in place (based on capacity guidance at that time)
 - High contact surfaces will be sanitized frequently.
 - Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the facility

Swim Lesson Protocols:

- We will have limits of 5 children per group in each swim lesson.
- There will be 15 minutes between each session to sanitize and to reduce the number patrons on deck
 - Masks will not be required for participants as long as social distance can be maintained
 - Hand sanitizer stations will be available for staff and participants
